GI Container Portable Parlours set up in Indore Sahakari Dugdh Sangh Maryadit under NPDD Scheme – B (DTC-JICA)

Indore Sahakari Dugdh Sangh Maryadit, Indore intends to establish Milk Parlours in its operational areas which are made from steel containers. These parlours will also act as rural distributors covering few villages around them.

The base structure of these parlours should be GI containers. For the interiors, cement board panels are to be used. Glass wool is to be used for insulation across all sides. The structure is to be fixed on raised cement platforms. The specs of Sanchi Parlors in GI Containers are given below:

- GI Portable Shop Cabins (10ft x 10ft x 8.6ft)
- Rolling shutter (10ft x 8ft)
- Sun shades (10ft x 5ft)
- Glass racks (48 sqft)
- ELCB
- Submeter
- Spot Lights(5 watt as per requirements)
- Roofing material shall be as per OEM standards. Roofing material shall be highly durable, industrial/commercial standards, light weight, corrosion resistant and shall with stand in kind of weathers.
- Branding material design will be provided by ISDS and entire branding material is in the scope of the these work across all sides of the parlour including interior and exterior of the container.

The surface of these containers should not get heated up during summers and therefore, the insulation has to be adequate.
